WARNING: Do not use alcohol or ammonia based products, dishwashing detergents/soaps, products that contain abrasives, or other chemicals. Use of cleaning products and methods other than those specified below will damage the vinyl and void the warranty.

CAUTION: Remove jewelry or other objects that can puncture or cut the vinyl before cleaning your CWS Weather-Lite Windows & Doors.

- 1.** Do not wash panels when hot or in direct sunlight. Using a garden hose, with non-well water, gently hose off the exterior of the panels to remove loose dirt, dust, or debris. Clean the main frame and vinyl jamb tracks with a soft cloth and clean water.
- 2.** Starting with the bottom panel, raise approximately 2-3 inches, pull to the spring side and tilt the vinyl sash inward, removing it from the opening. Repeat for remaining vents.
- 3.** Clean each vent with a soft, lint free, clean cloth and rinse it with clean water. A cleaning solution such as Woolite® or Murphy Oil Soap® and warm water (one cap-full to one gallon water) will work nicely and protect your investment. Ensure the panel is dry and free of spots. Replace each vent in the same position as removed.
- 4.** Final clean your panels with CWS Vinyl Cleaner available from your CWS distributor. It will extend the life of your Weather-Lite Windows & Doors and reduce static electric charges that attract dust.
